

Enjoy 5 walking trails and tours that tell the story of Rawlins and the West through art murals and historic sites.



### #2 Rawlins Interpretive Trail

1.3 miles, one-way - (dashed light blue line)

Walk from Rawlins Springs to the Wyoming Frontier Prison grounds. Highlights include several interpretive signs throughout downtown Rawlins and the community.

### #5 Rawlins Walking Path

7.5 mile loop - (solid red line)

Walk along a paved path that loops around Rawlins. Restrooms and water are available at the Memorial Sports Complex, Bolton Park and 4th & Front Street.

# CARBON COUNTY TRAVEL ITINERARIES

## SNOWY RANGE SCENIC BYWAY TOUR

Highway 130 to Encampment & Saratoga

### TRIP HIGHLIGHTS

- Take a scenic drive through the **Medicine Bow National Forest** to see some of the most breathtaking and easily accessible peaks in the Rocky Mountains, including famed **Medicine Bow Peak** at 12,013 feet.
- Walk among 15 historic buildings dating back to the early 1890's to 1920 at the **Grand Encampment Museum**.
- Soak in Saratoga's natural **mineral hot spring "Hobo Pools"**.
- Tour the **Saratoga Museum** which is housed in the original 1915 Saratoga-Encampment Railroad Depot.



- Visit the **Saratoga Fish Hatchery**.
- Spend free time in **downtown Saratoga**. Shop western stores, browse art galleries, enjoy ice cream and dine in some of the best restaurants in Carbon County.

**Trip Sequence:** From I-80 Exit 311, turn south and follow WY 130 west through Centennial, WY. Continue west through the Medicine Bow National Forest, stopping at the Libby Flats Observation Point and the west Lake Marie parking area for a short walk and to take photos. Continue on the scenic byway to the WY130/230 junction. At the junction, turn south toward Encampment. Tour the Grand Encampment Museum and stop for lunch. Then return to Hwy 230 and travel north to Saratoga. Plan to tour the Saratoga Museum, shop, dine, soak in the hot pools and stay overnight.

## HISTORIC LINCOLN HIGHWAY TOUR

Highway 30 to Medicine Bow & Hanna; I-80 to Fort Steele, Sinclair & Rawlins

### TRIP HIGHLIGHTS

- **The Fossil Cabin**—a rare attraction built with dinosaur bones.
- Get a sense of the Old West through exhibits and railroad memorabilia at the **Medicine Bow Museum**.
- Step back in time at the **Historic Virginian Hotel**.
- Learn about underground coal mining in the Carbon and Hanna Basins at the **Hanna Basin Museum**.
- Visit the **Fort Steele State Historic Site**.
- Tour the **Parco/Sinclair Museum** to learn about the building of the oil refinery.
- Take a guided tour of the **Wyoming Frontier Prison** to hear interesting stories of the inmates, prison life and punishment --from hangings to the gas chamber.
- View fascinating western exhibits and over 30,000 artifacts at the **Carbon County Museum**.
- Explore **Historic Downtown Rawlins**. Rich in 19th century architecture, downtown Rawlins has several unique shops and stores and boasts a great selection of restaurants.
- Enjoy **5 Walking Trails and Tours** that tell the story of Rawlins and the West through art murals and historic sites.

**Trip Sequence:** From I-80 Exit 310, turn north and follow WY 30 (Historic Lincoln Highway) west to Medicine Bow. Plan to take pictures at The Fossil Cabin, tour the Museum and eat lunch at the Virginian Hotel. Then continue west to Hanna and tour the Museum. Continue west to the WY30/I-80 junction. Follow I-80 west to tour Fort Steele (Exit 228) and the Parco/Sinclair Museum (Exit 219) before arriving in Rawlins. Explore downtown, shop, dine and stay overnight. In the morning, tour the Wyoming Frontier Prison and the Carbon County Museum.

## BATTLE HIGHWAY SCENIC BYWAY TOUR

Highway 70 from Encampment to Savery & Baggs; Highway 789 & I-80 to Rawlins

### TRIP HIGHLIGHTS

- Walk among 15 historic buildings dating back to the early 1890's to 1920 at the **Grand Encampment Museum**.
- Cross the Continental Divide at **Battle Pass Summit**, 9,955 feet in elevation.
- See the **Edison monument** and learn about his vacation to Carbon County in 1878.
- Wander through 15 historic buildings, including Jim Baker's cabin, at the **Little Snake River Museum** in Savery.
- Tour the **Outlaw Stop** and the **Mathews-Gaddis House** in Baggs--both places were frequented by Butch Cassidy and his infamous Wild Bunch.

**Trip Sequence:** After touring the Grand Encampment Museum, follow WY 70 (Battle Highway Scenic Byway) west to Baggs. Plan take pictures at the Battle Pass Summit and the Edison Monument and tour the Little Snake River Museum. Then continue west to Baggs for lunch and to tour the Outlaw Shop and Mathews-Gaddis House. Travel north on WY 789 to I-80 and follow I-80 east to Rawlins. Spend the afternoon touring the Wyoming Frontier Prison and the Carbon County Museum. Then plan to explore downtown, shop, dine and stay overnight.
